Special Arrangements for Mother's Day

Deliveries for Mother Day – In preparation for Mother's Day, families may bring items in on Saturday, May 9th, from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. to be sanitized and delivered on Sunday. A letter has been mailed to all responsible parties for Cribbs and Grace Residents. There will be a designated drop location where families can bring one shopping bag of items. Families that wish to send flowers for Mother's Day, and are unable to bring them in on May 9th, may use an online or mail order delivery service, but the flowers must arrive by mail, FedEx, or UPS in a box.

Mother's Day Flowers:

Options for flower delivery: We can accept MAIL ORDER flowers delivered via USPS mail, UPS, or FedEx, and that ARRIVE IN A BOX.

If you order online, make sure that the flowers will be delivered via USPS mail, UPS, or FedEx, and that ARRIVE IN A BOX.

We can only accept deliveries by a local delivery person who is carrying in a vase on May 9th between 10:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. We will have a special drop off location where they can be sanitized.

Dropping off items:

Families may bring items in on Saturday, May 9th, from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. to be sanitized and delivered to Grace and Cribbs residents. Those with questions about dropping off items should call 814-332-9014.

This is ONLY on May 9th from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

Follow the signs to the drop off location on the Wesbury campus.

Wear a mask when dropping items off.

Limit the number of items to what will fit in one shopping bag.

All items must be labeled with the resident name and room number.

We are permitting:

- Snacks/Candy/Beverages
- Toiletry items
- Clothing – will be washed and labeled before given to the resident and will not occur by Mother's Day.
We will arrange for seasonal clothing exchanges on another date.
- Newspapers/Books/Periodicals
- Electronics (such as a TV, laptop, handheld device)
- Plants – only cut flowers and live floral arrangements, no potted plants are permitted.

Window visits:

We will resume scheduling Window Visits for Friday, May 8th, and beyond. This allows families to come to a designated window and speak to loved ones over the phone at Cribbs, Grace, and the Care Cottages. We also offer Skype and FaceTime. Prescheduled appointments are required.
