



October COVID Case Information

Wesbury COVID-19 Positive Test Information: On October 14, 2020, Wesbury received notice of its first positive case of COVID-19. The per diem employee, who works at both Grace Rehabilitation and Health Center and Cribbs Residential Center quarantined at home following appropriate medical guidance. Contact tracing was conducted. We tested all staff and residents on October 15th and 16th. On October 19, 2020, the October 15 and 16 COVID-19 test results indicated 2 new positives; 1 Grace staff and 1 Grace resident. There were no cases at Cribbs. The staff quarantined at home, and the asymptomatic resident moved to our COVID-19 unit at Grace. We retested all staff & residents on October 20 and 21. The 10/20-21 Grace and Cribbs staff and resident COVID-19 tests results are all negative! We are working with the Department Of Health to remove quarantine restrictions as appropriate. These differ by area. Visitation at Grace remains Window, Skype, and FaceTime at this time. Visitation at Cribbs is open to socially distanced face to face visits, Skype, and FaceTime.
