Becoming a volunteer

In order to maintain quality volunteer services, Wesbury requires that all volunteers:

- Be at least 13 years of age. (Minors must have parental consent.)
- Fill out a volunteer application
- Successfully complete a 2-step TB test
- Have a required Criminal Background Check completed
- Attend orientation/job training
